MICM STATEMENT OF FAITH

At MindKnit International Church Ministries, we stand in unity with the historic Christian faith as expressed in the Apostles' Creed, and we affirm the distinctives of the Reformed tradition, rooted in Scripture and centered on the gospel of grace.

We believe:

1. In God the Father Almighty

"I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth."

We believe God is sovereign over all things, the Creator and Sustainer of the universe. In His wisdom and love, He governs all history for His glory and our good.

2. In Jesus Christ, His Only Son, Our Lord

"I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary..."



We believe Jesus is fully God and fully man. He lived a sinless life, died on the cross for our sins, rose bodily from the grave, ascended into heaven, and will come again to judge the

living and the dead. Through His life, death, and resurrection, He accomplished salvation for all who believe.

3. In the Holy Spirit

"I believe in the Holy Spirit..."

We believe the Holy Spirit gives new life, convicts us of sin, empowers us for obedience, and unites us with Christ and His Church. The Spirit indwells every believer and is our Comforter and Counselor.

4. In the Holy Catholic (Universal) Church and the Communion of Saints

"...the holy universal Church, the communion of saints..."

We believe the Church is the body of Christ, made up of all true believers across the world and throughout history. The local church is where believers worship, grow in grace, serve one another, and proclaim Christ to the world.

We affirm that the Word of God must be rightly preached, the sacraments rightly administered, and church discipline faithfully exercised.

5. In the Forgiveness of Sins

"...the forgiveness of sins..."

We believe that all people are sinners in need of God's grace. Salvation is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone—not by works. In Christ, our sins are fully forgiven, and we are declared righteous before God.

This is the gospel's heart and the Reformed faith's hope.



6. In the Resurrection of the Body and the Life Everlasting

“...the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.”

We believe that Christ will return to judge the living and the dead. Believers will be raised to eternal life in God’s presence. This hope shapes our lives today—in worship, service, and joyful expectation. Rooted in Scripture, Reformed in Identity

While we confess the ancient faith summarized in the Apostles’ Creed, we are also joyfully shaped by the Reformed confessions such as the Westminster Confession of Faith, the Belgic Confession, and the Heidelberg Catechism. These help us understand the depth of God’s Sovereignty, the richness of His grace, and the call to live all of life to His glory.
